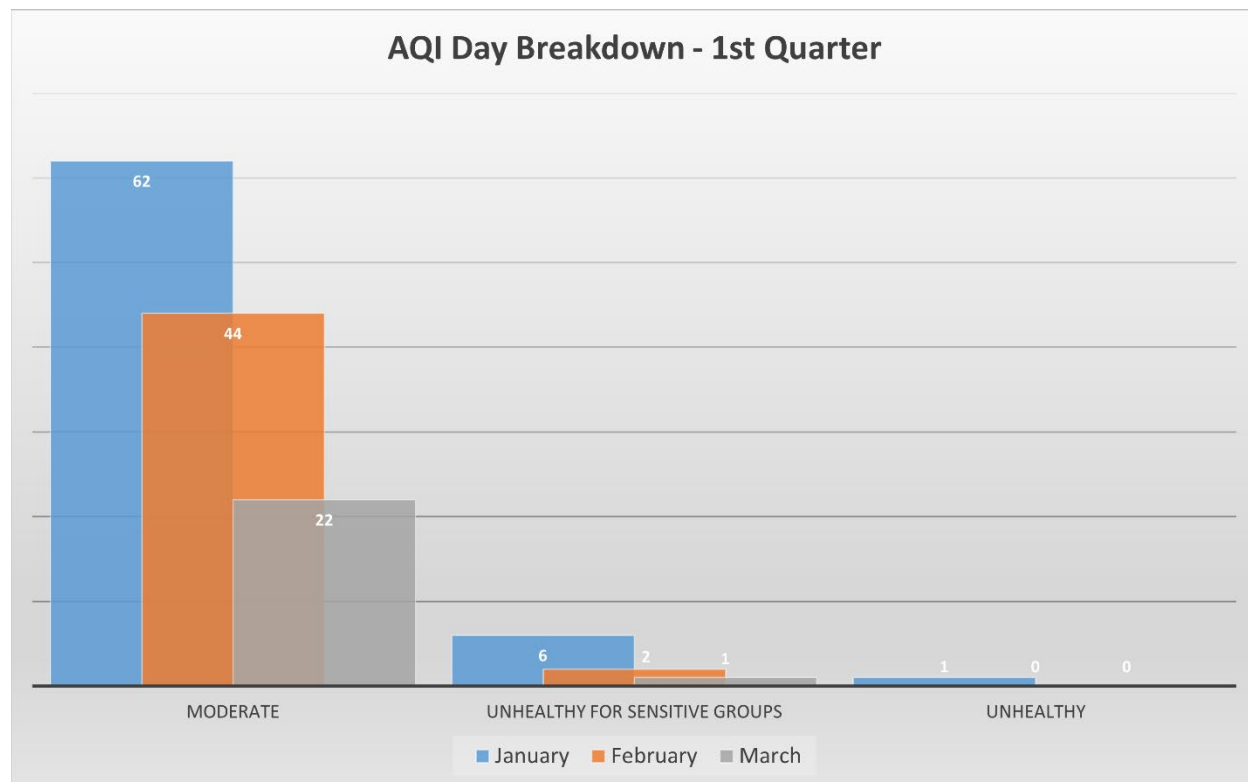

Description: Monitoring Update

AQI Exceedance Days:



Summary:

Plumas County was again responsible for the majority of Moderate and higher observed days during the 1st Quarter – 125 days of Moderate AQI were observed in Plumas County of a total of 128 Moderate days seen in the District. Additionally, 9 days of Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups (USG) and 1 day of Unhealthy AQI were also experienced in Plumas County.

As the quarter progressed, the air quality progressively improved. 50% of the Moderate or higher days were observed in January while only 16.67% were observed in March.

Additionally, a prescribed fire outside of Quincy on 3/3 & 3/4 contributed to the lone USG day in March.
